- **GRADUATION CEREMONIES IN KLETSK AND RADOSHKOVICH ORPHANAGES**



Graduation is one of the most special moments in the life of an orphan. It is the time when he or she leaves the only home they've had for years and they are going out into the wide world, alone. It is important to help them make feel special at this time. For several years we have tried to help orphans in a few orphanages get nice hair cuts and make up (and sometimes rent a nice dress ware for the occasion).

- **WARM HOMES RUNNING: SAYING GOOD-BYE TO SOME OF OUR ORPHANS**

Warm Homes (Lena's, Tamara's and Larisa's in Pinsk) as well as our Centre in Kolodischi (despite the ongoing repairs) are running. Every weekend teens continue to gather together in the Centre in Kolodischi to pray for their needs, the ministry as well as for our partners.

We are also saying to good-bye to some of our teens, who have been with us for two or three years. They have now finished their education and are either continuing their studies at the next level or started working.
